

## PUBLICATIONS

In order to ensure the high scientific standard of our conference only a limited number of outstanding papers written in English or Hungarian will be selected for oral or poster presentations. The selected (peer-reviewed) papers will be published in our on-line repository (with ISBN), which has been freely accessible since 2012 at [napok.georgikon.hu](http://napok.georgikon.hu) with an average number of downloads of 4-500 or even 2,800 in certain cases.

*The best papers of each session will be invited for publication in the scientific journal Georgikon for Agriculture. The papers chosen for the journal will be reviewed by two reviewers.*

## REGISTRATION, FEES, SELECTION PROCEDURE

---

The registration fee of the conference is € 65 for early birds before 1<sup>st</sup> June and € 130 thereafter. It covers the conference participation, two lunches, coffee and refreshments and the reception with conference dinner on 3<sup>rd</sup> October. Without catering etc. the participation with publication only is € 20 if registering before 1<sup>st</sup> June and € 30 after that. You can register for the conference till 30<sup>th</sup> August by registering on-line, submitting an abstract of your oral or poster presentation and confirming the payment of the registration fee.

The Programme Committee reserves the right to select or refuse papers for oral or poster presentation exclusively on the basis of scientific content. The authors of the selected abstracts will be invited to submit the full paper versions (max. 8-10 pages) till 15<sup>th</sup> September 2019. For more detail: <http://napok.georgikon.hu>
