In order to ensure the high scientific standard of our conference only a limited number of outstanding papers written in English or Hungarian will be selected for oral or poster presentations. The selected (peer-reviewed) papers will be published in our on-line repository (with ISBN), which has been freely accessible since 2012 at [napok.georgikon.hu](http://napok.georgikon.hu) with an average number of downloads of 800-1000 or even 4,000 in certain cases.

*The best papers of each session will be invited for publication in the scientific journal Georgikon for Agriculture. The papers chosen for the journal will be reviewed by two reviewers.*

## REGISTRATION, FEES, SELECTION PROCEDURE

The registration fee of the conference with two lunches, coffee and refreshments and the reception with conference dinner is € 100. The Registration fee for one day with lunch, coffee and refreshments is € 50. Without catering etc. the participation with publication is € 25. You can register for the conference till 15th August by registering on-line, submitting an abstract of your oral or poster presentation. By registering you agree to pay the appropriate registration fee.

The Programme Committee reserves the right to select or refuse papers for oral or poster presentation exclusively based on its scientific content.
